

BEML to set up₹316-cr facility

BEML Ltd is setting up an ₹ 316-crore facility in Bangalore for its aerospace related business. The Defence major has been allocated 25 acres on a 217-acre designated aerospace SEZ at Devanahalli in Bangalore Rural.

The new BEML unit will hire 250 people and provide design and manufacturing services in aircraft components, sub-assemblies and MRO (maintenance, repair and overhaul) activities. BEML signed an MoU with the Karnataka Government for its fourth manufacturing complex in the State — after Bangalore, Mysore and Kolar Gold Fields.

Indo Schottle at QuEST SEZ

Automotive components maker Indo Schottle signed an MoU with QuEST Global on Thursday to set up a facility at QuEST's global SEZ in Belgaum. Indo Schottle will initially invest ₹ 20 crore in the centre, which will manufacture and export engine parts, hydraulic components and cold forged components. This marks Indo Schottle's entry into the aerospace sector, a QuEST release said.

Sequent Scientific

Sequent Scientific Ltd said it would set up three new facilities for three new therapeutic segments at a greenfield site in Bangalore. It would invest ₹ 150 crore over two years. An MoU was signed with the State Government during the Global Investors' Meet.


